II. Youth Unemployment in Cyprus

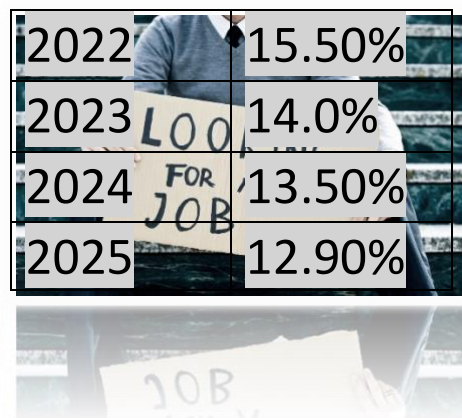
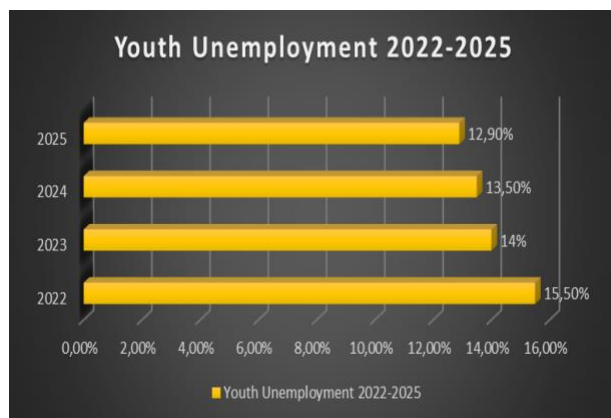
