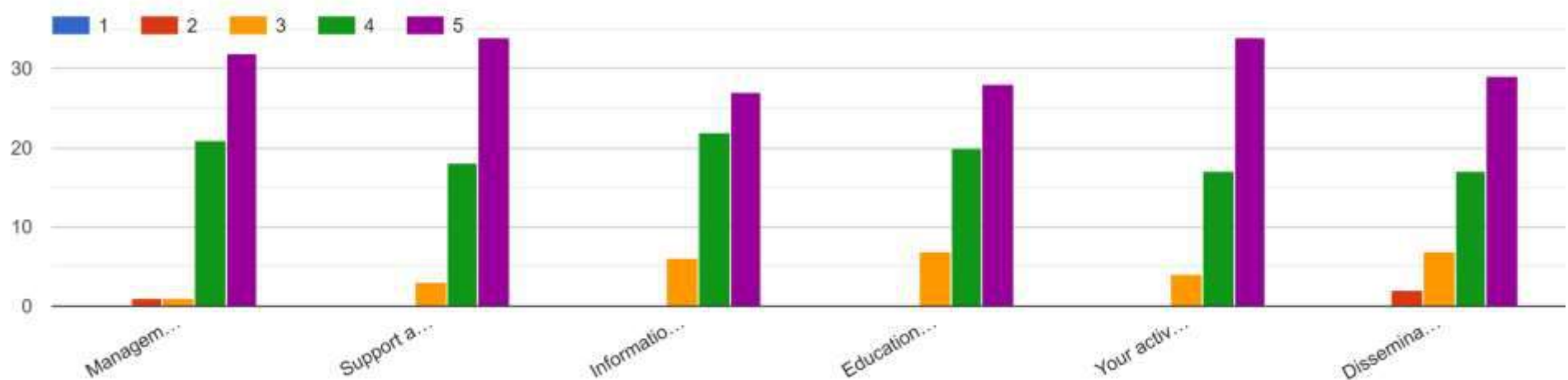

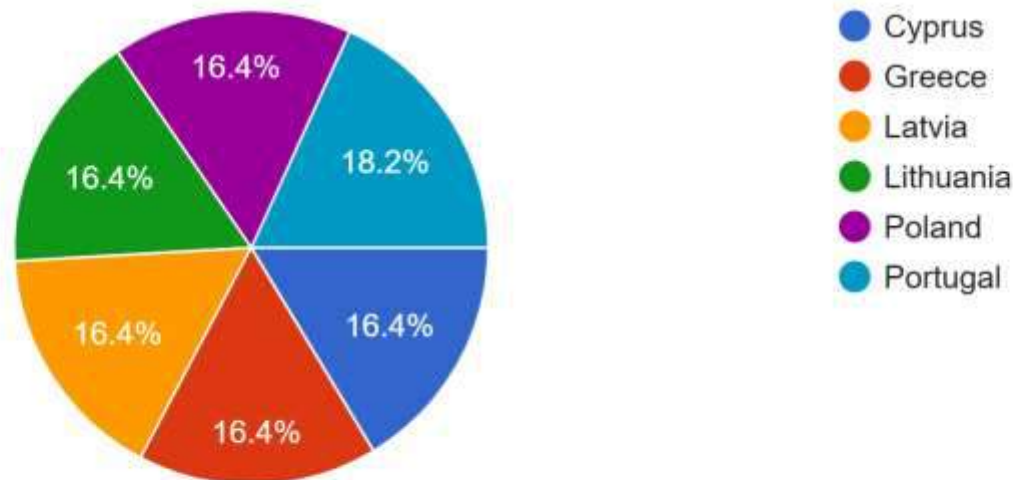

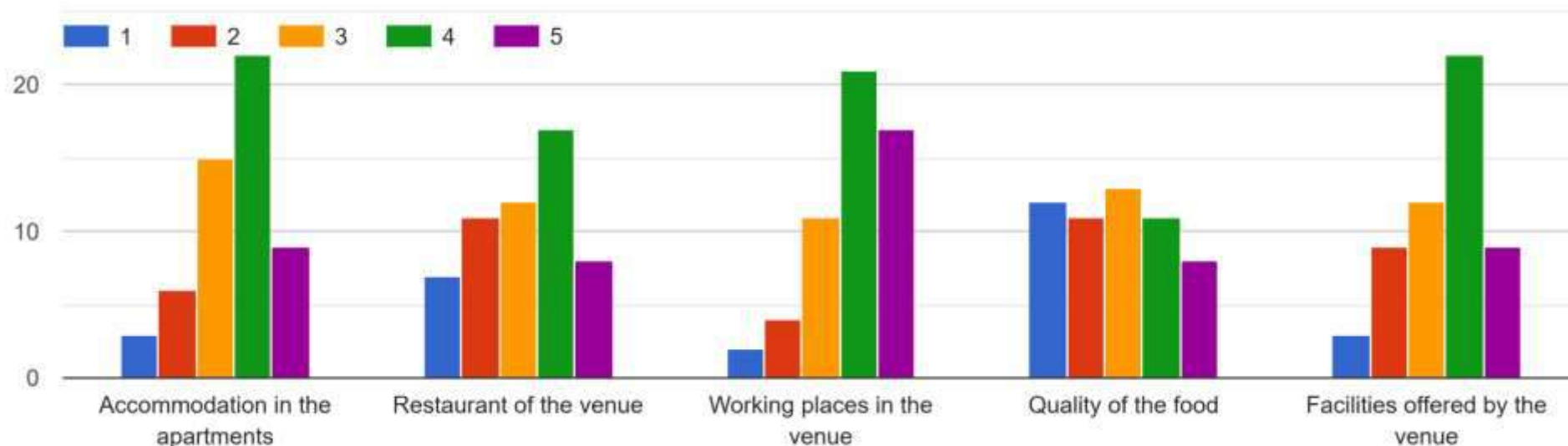

The food should be more nutritious

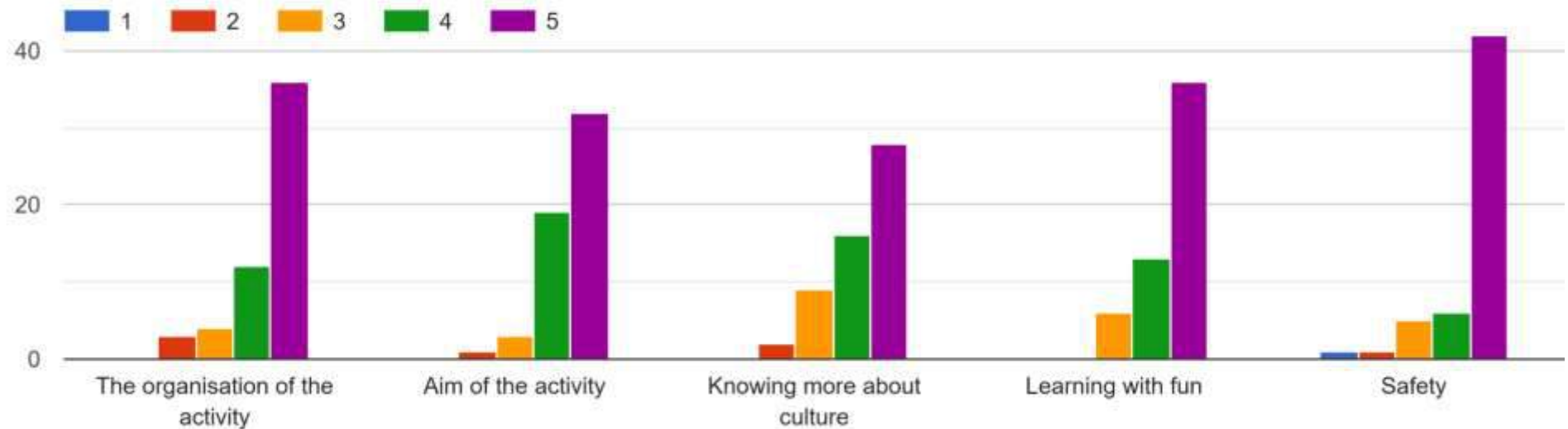

I loved that the food was latvian, especially the deserts. The participants could be distributed by the houses in a more equal way, so every one on the teams is together or mixed.

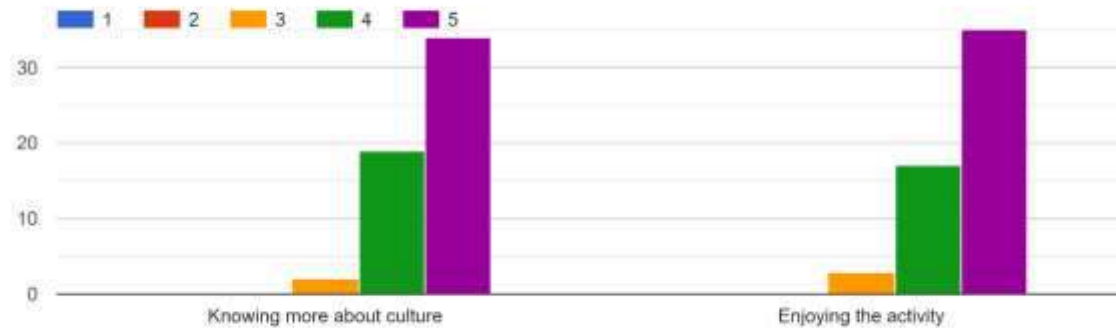

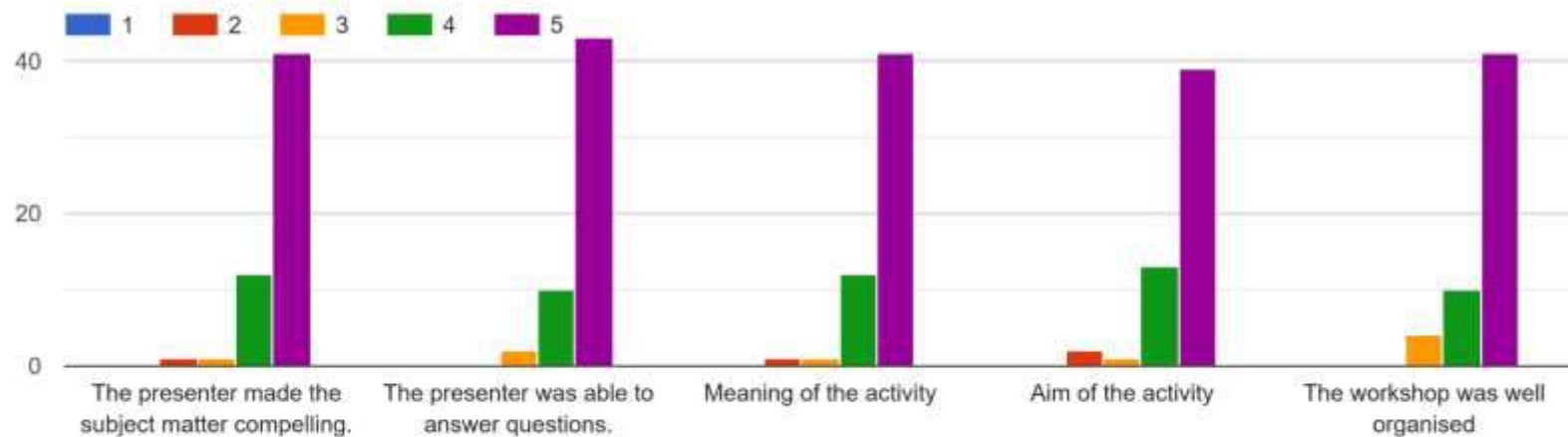

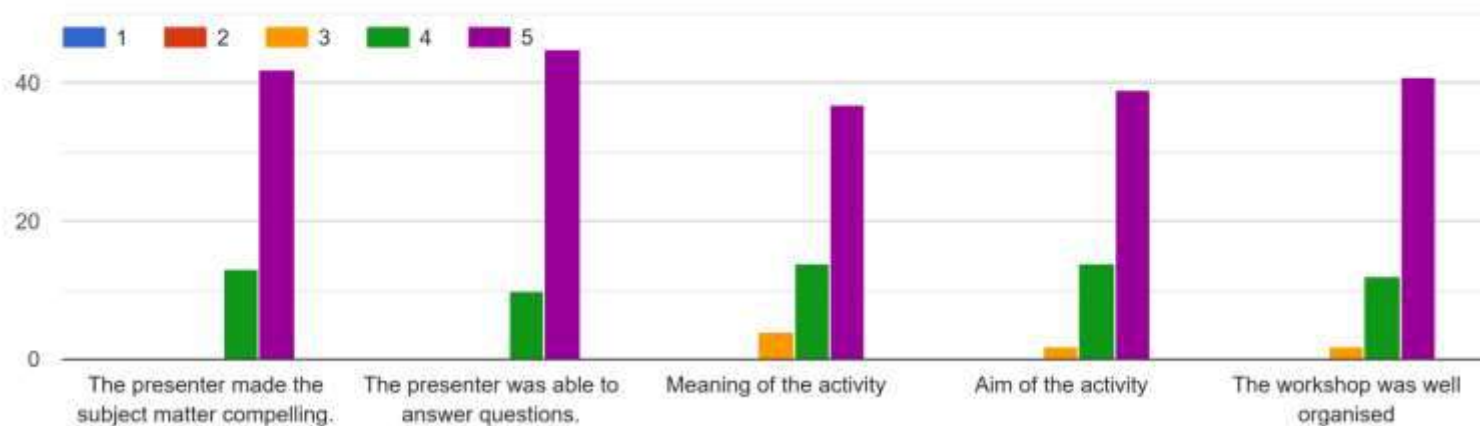
World Café (Wednesday afternoon). This was the session with 6 different stations with 6 different topics based on the project. Evaluate the activity according your expectations:



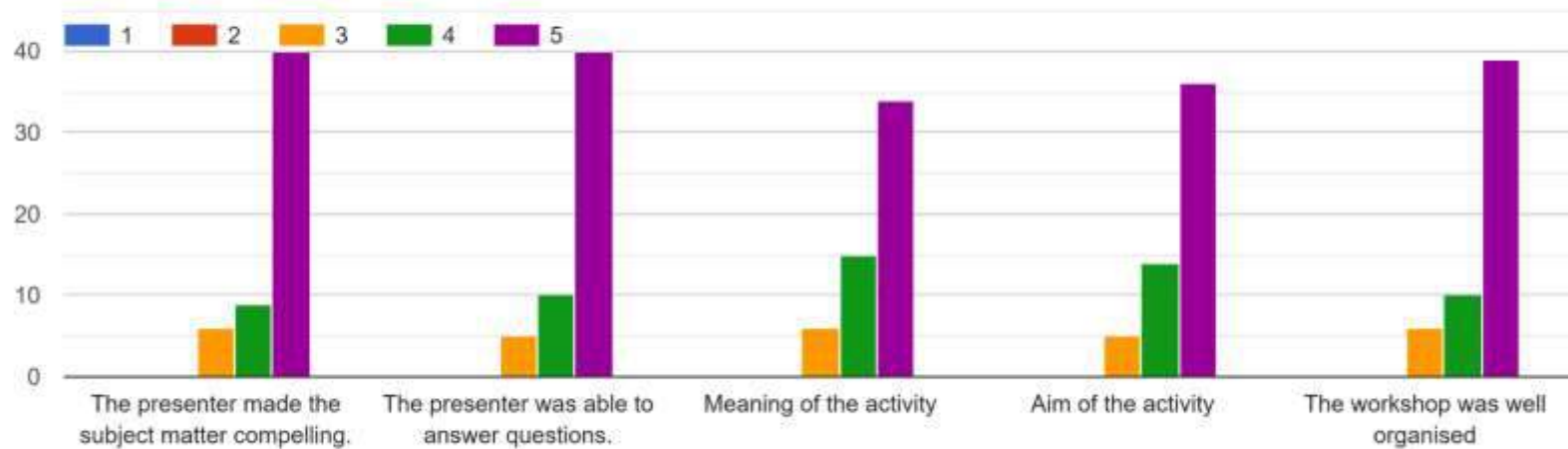
